Alef-Bet Adventure

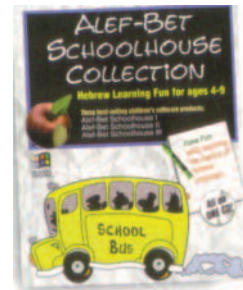

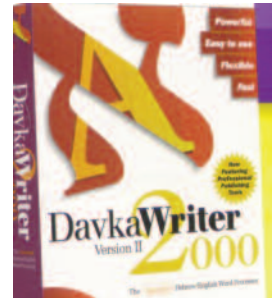

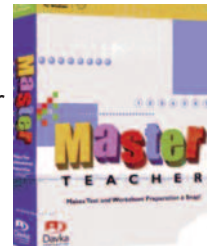
